# Tone of Voice

PANORAMA's voice is clear, credible, and purpose-driven — grounded in science and innovation, but always communicating with relevance and precision. Whether addressing researchers, policymakers, or stakeholders, the tone should remain confident and forward-thinking.

## Tone

- Professional but never overly complex
- Concise but informative
- Technically sound yet easy to follow
- Scientifically grounded with real-world relevance

Use well-structured language and avoid unnecessary jargon, especially in outreach materials. Always aim to bridge the gap between advanced research and real-world impact.

## Key messages

Strategic phrases that express PANORAMA's mission, impact, and added value. The following core messages help unify communication across platforms and express PANORAMA's mission and impact:

- Turning next generation earth observation into real-world impact.
- Transforming satellite data into insight
- Supporting climate action, disaster resilience, and sustainable development

# Logo

The PANORAMA logo is the primary visual mark of the project and should be used consistently to ensure brand recognition across all platforms. It reflects the project's clean, forward-looking identity and should always be displayed with clarity and appropriate spacing.

## Primary version

The primary logotype includes the signature tagline “observe | connect | protect” and is designed for use on light backgrounds. This version should be the default wherever possible.

## Usage Guidelines

- Maintain clear space around the logo equal to the height of the "P" in PANORAMA.
- Do not stretch, rotate, or alter the colors or proportions.
- Use the appropriate file format for the medium (e.g., SVG for digital, PNG/JPG for presentations, EPS/PDF for print).
- When placed on dark backgrounds, use the reversed version provided.

## Incorrect Uses

Avoid placing the logo over busy images, applying shadows, changing fonts, or modifying the tagline. Always preserve the integrity of the original design.

# Logomark

## Usage

Use the logomark in digital icons, social media avatars, favicons, branded assets, or layout elements where the full logo may not fit.

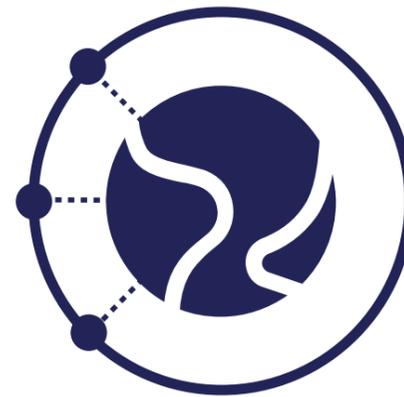
## Available Versions

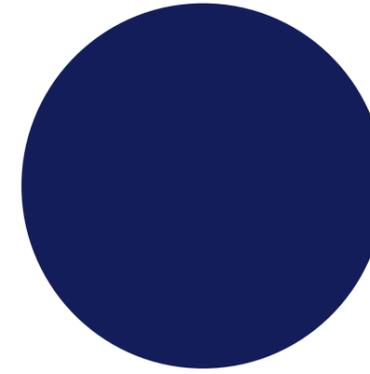

# Colors

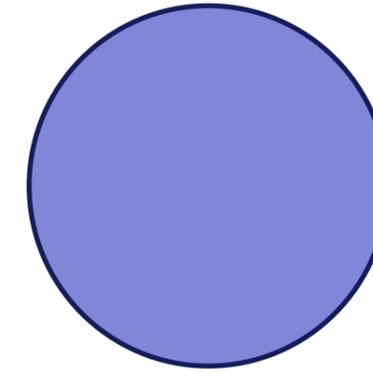

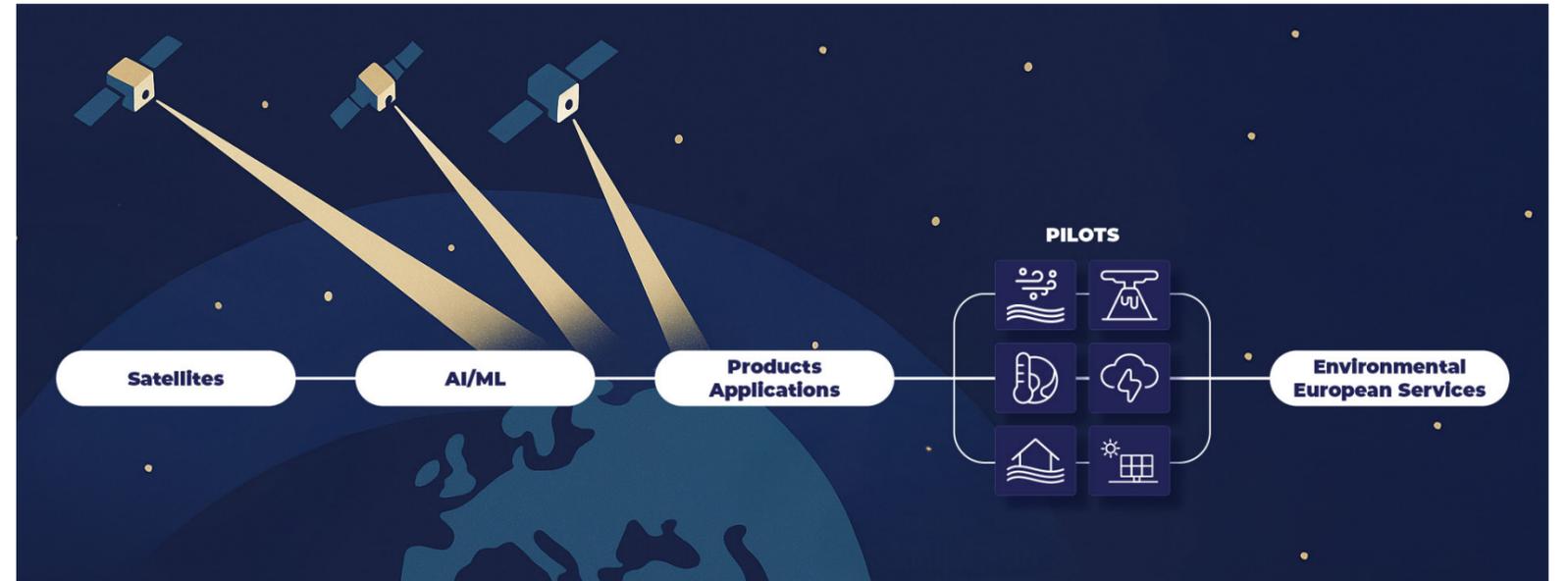
# Icons
